

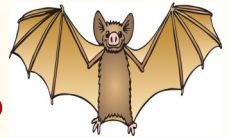

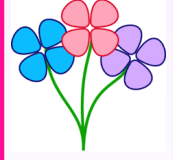
Bats play an important role in nature but may also carry rabies
