WHEREAS, The New York State Employees' Retirement System requires that a standard workday be established for all County of Albany employees, including elected and appointed officials, for retirement reporting purposes, and

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 425 for 2024, this Honorable Body established such a standard workday for retirement reporting purposes, and,

WHEREAS, An amendment is necessary in order to reflect the actual accruals for certain members, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature, that Resolution No. 425 for 2024 is hereby amended to reflect a revised Records of Activity for the following individuals:

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
